Useful Tips

Here are our top tips for making the most of a university open day:

- Preparation is key for a successful open day, so plan ahead, know where you're going and jot down the things you want to find out.
- Print out a campus map to help find your way around on the day.
- Sign-up for presentations and tours ahead of time – open days are often oversubscribed.
- Talk to current students about their campus experience. Student ambassadors are often the best people to ask for honest advice and guidance.
- If you're a student, don't let your parents ask all the questions. Ultimately, the decision on which university you attend and the course you study rests with you. Over-eager parent? Try not to steer from the back seat, and let your child make their own mind up about a particular uni.
